

ADOLFO CAMARILLO HIGH SCHOOL RECYCLING CLUB CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE I- PURPOSE

The purpose of the Adolfo Camarillo High School Recycling Club is to allow students at Camarillo High School to complete community service hours, earn money through recycling, and contribute to a greener more environmentally friendly school campus.

ARTICLE II-AFFILIATION

This organization shall be an affiliated branch of and comply with the authority of Adolfo Camarillo High School and the Oxnard Union High School District.

ARTICLE III- ADMINISTRATION

Section 1- The President, Advisors, members, and parent volunteers shall govern the ACHS Recycling Club.

Section 2- They shall have the power to enforce the Constitution and ability to amend it as they deem fit.

Section 3- A vote may be taken on any issue of concern to see where members and parents stand. Discussion will be allowed to offer opinions and suggestions.

Section 4- Final authority is given to the President and Advisor under the provision that they are working in the best interest of the club.

ARTICLE IV-MEMBERSHIP

Section 1- Membership shall be allowed to any student and recycling enthusiast attending Adolfo Camarillo High School.

Section 2 Club Lettering provided by the ACHS Recycling Club will be reserved for those members which:

1. Attend 75% of all scheduled meetings
2. Remain in good academic standing with a 2.0 GPA
3. Attend 2 out of 3 special recycling events per school year.

Section 4- All members shall remain in good academic standing, set an example of citizenship, integrity, and honor at school, in the community, and at all special recycling events.

Section 5- Any deviation from the standards set in Section 4 shall result in probation or separation from the ACHS recycling Club. The advisor and president shall make this determination.

ARTICLE V-MEETINGS

Meetings shall be called weekly on Wednesdays or as needed. All members will be required to attend for give advanced notice of their absence.
