

Information about SAT at ACHS

SAT registration bulletins are available in the ACHS Career Center for mail-in registration. Students may also register at www.collegeboard.com. If registering on the Internet, please be sure to print the admission ticket; make sure to bring admission tickets to the testing.

Students should park in ACHS upper parking lot, and be at the cafeteria by 8:00 a.m. Photo ID and admission tickets will be checked, and students will be released to the individual testing rooms. Acceptable photo ID includes school ID cards, state-issued licenses or ID's, military photo ID, and passports. Students without photo ID will not be permitted to take the SAT, with the exception of 7th and 8th grade talent search students.

The SAT reasoning test takes 3 hours, 45 minutes, and the SAT Subject tests takes 1 - 3 hours, depending on the number of tests taken. Assume time for answer sheet bubbling and breaks. Students leaving the testing center early during SAT Reasoning Tests will have their scores cancelled. Students taking SAT Subject Tests may leave at the end of the hour in which their last test is taken, but may not leave early if they finish early. Those picking up students may not remain on campus during the testing.

Students should have at least two #2 pencils and a four-function, scientific, or graphing calculator for the math sections. If a student is taking a language test, they must bring their own cassette player. The following devices may not be used as calculators:

- Pocket organizers
- PDA's/ Handheld computers
- Electronic writing pads
- Pen/stylus input devices
- Calculators with a typewriter keypad
- Calculators that use paper tape, make noise, or require an electrical outlet
- Cell phone calculators

Food and drink may be brought into the room, but must remain sealed until breaks and consumed outside of the room. Cell phones must be turned off before the test, and may not be used at any time until the test is complete. Students may not bring books of any kind, papers, etc, into the testing room, or have any other materials aside from pencils and calculators on their desks.

Students may be released from the testing, at the discretion of room/site supervisors, if they:

- Give or receive help of any kind
- Look through the test booklet before the test
- Work on the wrong section, or return to a previous section
- Mark the answer sheet after time is called
- Attempt to remove test materials from the testing room
- Use any unauthorized test aids
- Attempt to take the test for someone else.

If released, scores will be cancelled, and money paid will not be refunded.

Students wishing to make test changes, center changes, date changes, or to test standby are admitted in that order on a first-come, first-served basis. While ACHS can normally accommodate changes and standbys, there is no guarantee without the student being registered at ACHS and taking the test to which they were assigned. Students wishing to test standby should pick up a SAT registration bulletin at the Career Center during the week, and bring it to the testing center on the day of testing.
